TECADE, continuously improving

New construction processes and improvement of facilities: NEW BLASTING AND PAINTING BOOTH

Tecade has installed 2 new painting and blasting booths at our facilities in the Port of Seville (Tecade Yard). Our goal is to improve service to our client. In order to satisfy the growing demands for our products, we continue to increase our production capacity.

Tecade has now 4 enclosures fully operational all of which are available for simultaneous use to offer the best service possible and finishing required to the structures for our Offshore and Steel Bridges projects. Furthermore, we are currently working on the two painting workshop refurbishment belonging to the former shipyard.





Improvement of machinery: A NEW CYLINDER has been acquired by Tecade

The workload coming from offshore industry undertaken by Tecade is requiring the need for expanding the capacity of sheet bending.

Tecade strives to continually improve and renew its services which has lead it to incorporate a new cylinder at its facilities at the Port of Seville, TECADE YARD.

This new acquisition has a higher rolling capacity: up to 222mm thickness and it can reach up to 4 meters ferrule long; benefiting us to improve our capacities and the possibility to cope with a challenging future.

JOHAN SVERDRUP PROJECT

Johan Sverdrup is one of the five largest oil fields on the Norwegian continental shelf. With expected resources of between 1.9—3.0 billion barrels of oil equivalents, it will also be one of the most important industrial projects in Norway in the next 50 years.

Tecade is pursuing its remarkable expansion and continues its strong performance through the award of contracts around the world.

We awarded the contract for two important work packages for Johan Sverdrup LQ oil rig in Norway.

The awarding of this contract is a new step forward to the company because it is the heaviest structure in the whole Jacket (with an amount of 2400Tn) which means, by implication, the opening up of new fields of activity, and the execution in greater scale of projects.

The project is associated to 40.000 working hours . It started last September and we will finish our contribution throughout the month of April.
